KAMCHATKA BEAR HUNT



AREA:

Esso/Tigil; Palana

METHOD OF HUNTING:

In early spring April 23rd to May 25th snow machines are used for transportation, with final stalk on snow shoes or cross country ski's. Late spring May 5th to the 25th boats are used along with snow shoes and cross country ski's for spotting and stalking. **FALL** hunting is done on foot and with raft along active salmon streams. Fall bears are also spotted and stalked on berry patches and feeding areas.

TIME:

April 23rd to May 25th
September 1st through October 15th

GROUP SIZE:

Up to 12 hunters, 2-3 per camp

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Tents or cabins

ITINERARY:

- DAY 1** Arrive in Anchorage, Alaska and hotel
- DAY 2** Fly to Petropavlovsk, a five hour direct flight, transfer 500 Km by car to Esso and overnight
- DAY 3** Fly by helicopter to the hunting area, about 1 hour
- DAYS 4-12** 9 day hunt
- DAY 13** Fly to Esso, transfer to Petropavlovsk and overnight
- DAY 14** Return to Anchorage

HUNT FEE INCLUDES:

1X1 professional guide. Food, lodging and full camp gear during the hunt. Helicopter charter to and from the hunting camp. Skinning, fleshing and complete field care of trophies. Interpreter. Arrangements and assistance in shipping trophies home.

HUNT FEE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

Hotels before & after hunt. Meals and alcoholic beverages in Petropavlovsk, Moscow or other International Port of Entry. Extra or personal helicopter charters (\$1,000.00 per hour). International Air Fares. Cost of shipping trophies back home to US. Items of a personal nature.

SUGGESTED EQUIPMENT LIST:

Leather and rubber hunting boots, camp or tennis shoes, (snow packs on spring hunt, one change of outer hunting clothes, two sets long underwear, two pairs gloves, rain gear or gortex outer gear, layered underclothes (wool sweater, vests etc.), medium weight down or fiber fill parka, ten socks and ten pairs of shorts, camera& film, toilet kit and personal gear, sun glasses, good sleeping bag preferably "mummy type" of at least 3 pounds fill weight. Hunting guests should bring a large size duffle bag for transporting their bear hide back with them as excess baggage.

CAMPS AND HUNTING:

Camps are tents and sometimes cabins. They are warm, clean and comfortable but have no modern conveniences. Hunting in **SPRING** (April 23rd to May 5th) Is done in deep snow with snow machine and final stalks on snowshoe or cross country ski's. After May 5th the snow is less and hunting is more on foot and with the use of a boat for spotting.

FALL hunts are done on foot, spotting and stalking, observing active Salmon streams, berry patches and feeding areas.
