

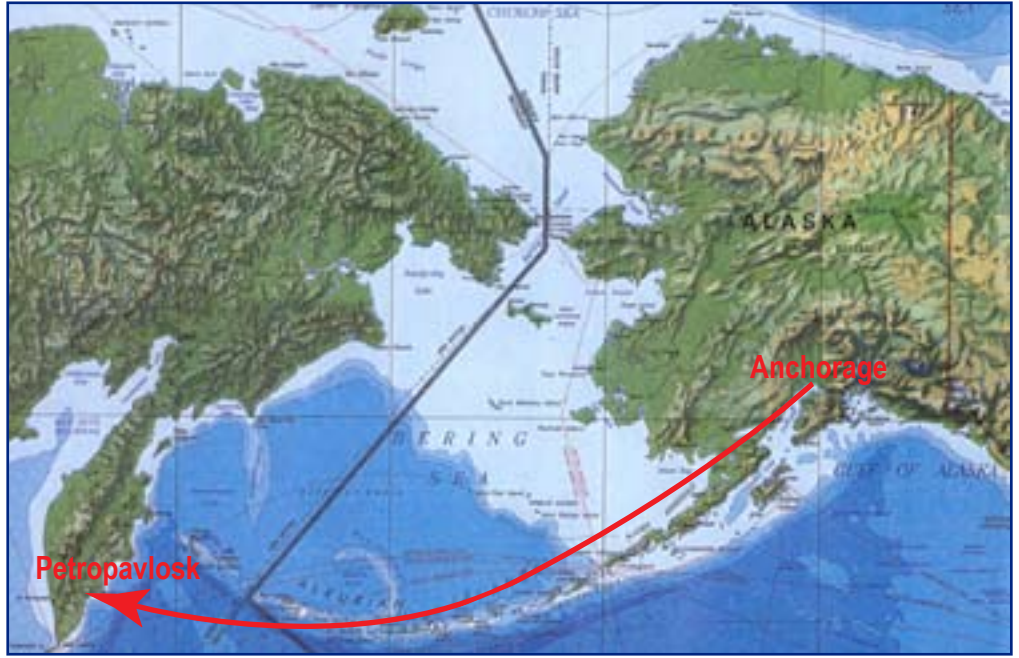

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## GIANT KAMCHATKA MOOSE HUNT



### TIME:

September 15th through November

### GROUP SIZE:

Minimum 3, Maximum 5 hunters per camp,  
Two camps are available.

### ACCOMMODATION:

Tent camp



### ITINERARY:

- Day 1 Arrive in Anchorage or Moscow and hotel
- Day 2 Arrive in Petropavlovsk, drive to Esso & hotel
- Day 3-12 Chopper to hunting camp and begin 10 day hunt
- Day 13 Return to Esso and then back to Petropavlovsk & hotel
- Day 14 Fly home

**COSTS INCLUDE:**

Experienced guide, accommodations and meals in the hunting camp, transport to and from hunting camp by helicopter, professional field care of trophies and assistance shipping trophies home to US.

**COSTS (FEE) DOES NOT INCLUDE:**

Hotels, meals and alcoholic drinks before and after hunt in Petropavlovsk or other International Port of Entry, International air fares and Russian charters or air fare, items of a personal nature, or Visa fees, about \$250.00.



## **SUGGESTED EQUIPMENT LIST:**

Leather and rubber hunting boots, camp or tennis shoes, (snow packs on spring hunt, one change of outer hunting clothes, two sets long underwear, two pairs gloves, rain gear or gortex outer gear, layered underclothes (wool sweater, vests etc.), medium weight down or fiber fill parka, ten socks and ten pairs of shorts, camera& film, toilet kit and personal gear, sun glasses, good sleeping bag preferably “mummy type” of at least 3 pounds fill weight. Hunting guests should bring a large size duffle bag for transporting their bear hide back with them as excess baggage.

## **CAMPS AND HUNTING:**

Camps are tents and sometimes cabins. They are warm, clean and comfortable but have no modern conveniences. Camps are accessed by helicopter and are located in areas of densest moose populations. Hunting is done on foot, glassing the hillsides and feeding areas, and calling during the rut. Helicopters can be used for ariel surveys and assisting to get the meat and antlers out.

## **HOW TO GET THERE:**

It's just as easy as hunting Alaska! Kamchatka hunts originate from Petropavlovsk, Kamchatsky, a four hour direct flight from Anchorage, Alaska via Magadan Airlines which depart Anchorage International Airport every Friday at 5:30 AM. Guests overnight in Anchorage then depart for Petropavlovsk the following day. Hunters are met when they arrive and transported to hunting camp by helicopter.

**PAYMENTS AND DEPOSITS:** Deposits can be personal check, money order or cashiers check.  
**FINAL PAYMENT:** Final payment is due 60 days prior to start of hunt. Last minute bookings and final payments must be in negotiable funds, cash, cashiers check or money order.

**VISAS AND FIREARMS IMPORT/EXPORT PERMITS:** To acquire your visa we need from our guests three standard passport photo's and a good quality photo copy of both sides of the front page of your passport. For **FIREARMS PERMIT** a complete description if your rifle is required. An information form will be provided to you for the firearm permit.

**ABOUT SIBERIA AND KAMCHATKA:** Russia is the largest country in the world, six million square miles. One million square miles is considered European Russia, the remaining five million square miles, two and one half times the size of the forty eight states, is considered Siberia. This is the world's last true frontier! It is almost totally undeveloped. It has areas as large as the forty-eight states without a highway!  
**KAMCHATKA** is in Far Eastern Siberia. It is a peninsula consisting of one hundred and eighty thousand square miles of mountains, volcanoes, salmon streams and the world's largest moose.
